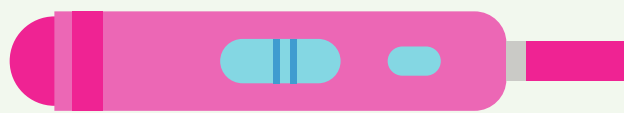


# INFERTILITY IN BLACK WOMEN

Black women are 1.8 times more likely to have infertility than women of other races.



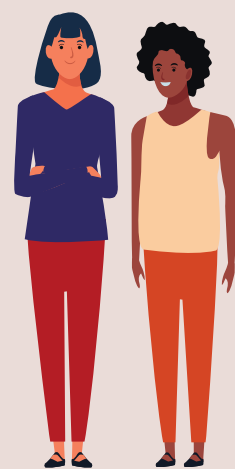
Black women are also more likely to have blocked fallopian tubes or uterine factors such as fibroids as their infertility diagnosis.

Black women have a greater duration of infertility before seeking evaluation by a fertility specialist or undergoing treatment.



When black women do attain access to ART, they have a lower chance of a successful live birth and a higher risk of miscarriage.

Only about 8% of black women between the ages of 25 and 44 seek medical help to get pregnant.
